

NCSSSA 2014 Membership Survey

The National Conference of State Social Security Administrators (NCSSSA) is the only professional organization for State Social Security Administrators and their staff. The NCSSSA Membership Committee, which is comprised of all of the Regional Vice Presidents and the current Vice-President Designate of NCSSSA, is conducting this brief survey of the states to determine what constraints are facing each state and U.S. territories in their ability to perform their federally mandated responsibilities. (NOTE: For the purposes of this survey, the word "state" refers to all 50 U.S. states, plus Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands.) We also want to identify what NCSSSA can do to better assist the states and territories in performing their State Social Security Administrators duties.

The results of this survey will be provided to NCSSSA members via GoogleGroups and during one of the business sessions at the 2014 Annual Conference in New Orleans. The information obtained from the survey will also be used during the Sunday Regional Caucus break-out session.
